Sample Information

California became the 31st state on September 9, 1850 [Becomes Questions 1 and 2]. The Golden State's rich history has since been shaped by people of every ethnic background who traveled here seeking economic, social and educational opportunity, and a life of quality and breathtaking beauty.

California situated its first capital in San Jose [Question 3]. The city did not have facilities ready for a proper capital, and the winter of 1850 - 1851 was unusually wet, causing the dirt roads to become muddy streams. [Question 4]. The legislature was unsatisfied with the location, so former General and State Senator Mariano Guadalupe Vallejo donated land in the future city of Vallejo for a new capital [Question 5 and 6*]; the legislature convened there for one week in 1852 and again for a month in 1853.
